How to See Your Doctor or another Clinician

This number operates Mon-Fri 8.00am - 6.30pm. Over 70% of our appointments are routine pre-bookable, these are all 10 minute slots. Either ring the surgery to book one of these or book on-line at our website or via the NHS App. (Pre registration to use this service is required - contact reception for information). These can be face to face or telephone appointments.

However, if you have an acute problem and you feel you need to be seen by a clinician on that day, you should ring the surgery from 8am on the day, our Care Navigator will ask you what the problem is and then book you an appointment with the most appropriate clinician, if we have capacity, which could be our Paramedic, Physician Associate, Mental Health Practitioner, Nurse or Doctor or direct you to a Pharmacy, or other service.

Continuity of Care/Named Accountable GP

All patients have a named accountable GP.

<u>Practice Nurses - Treatment Room</u>

Our practice nurses undertake a variety of general nursing duties, they also offer NHS health checks, NHS travel vaccinations and run diabetic, cervical smear, flu and other specialist clinics.

The nurses are seen by prior appointment. Please call reception to book an appointment or to speak to a nurse. Cervical smears are available every day by pre-booked appointments.

Child vaccinations are given throughout the week. Attendance is by pre-booked appointment - contact the surgery to book.

Additional Clinical Staff

We have other clinical staff who work under the supervision of our Doctors

We have a Paramedic, Physician Associate, 3 x Pharmacists, a Physiotherapist, a Young Persons Mental Health Practitioner and Adult Mental Health Practitioners and also non-clinical Social Prescribers and an Occupational Therapist who are all available to speak or see patients.

Brentwood GP Extended Access Hub

Teaching Practice

The Tile House is a teaching practice.

We have GP Registrars in attendance and also, from time to time, 1st and 4th year medical students. If you do not wish to have the medical students in the room whilst you are with the doctor please let reception know.

Non Attendance of an appointment

This ensures other patients can access our services. In some cases contact will be made to remind patients of the importance to cancel any unwanted appointments.

Home Visits

You will be asked what your problem is and the duty doctor will phone you and, if appropriate, will arrange for you to receive a visit. Requests for non-urgent home visits can be made in advance.

<u>Test Results (Blood, X-ray etc) & Medical Secretary</u> Please telephone 01277 227711 and press option 1

Mon-Thu 8am to 6.30pm, Fri 8am-5pm. It is your responsibility to check your results and to make an appointment with your doctor if you are advised to do so. Please do not ask Reception staff for information about your test results. Test results will only be given out to the person they relate to, unless that person has given prior permission, or they are not capable of understanding them.

Enquiries about tests ordered by the Hospital should be directed to the relevant hospital. If you would like access to your results online please speak to a member of the Reception staff.

Repeat Prescriptions

Please telephone **01277 227711 and press option 2** Mon-Fri 8am and 6.30pm if you have a query about your repeat prescription, please note that we <u>do not</u> accept requests for repeat prescriptions over the telephone.

Please allow 48 hours notice (Monday to Friday) when ordering a repeat prescription.

We only accept written requests for repeat prescriptions at the surgery.

The following are ways to request your repeat prescription:-

- placing your request in the box at the repeat prescription counter or post into our letter box at weekends
- by post to the Surgery address
- via your pharmacy
- via the NHS App
- via our website, www.tilehousesurgery.com. (You need to register to use this service, contact the surgery for details).
 All prescriptions are now sent to your preferred pharmacy electronically, you can register your preferred pharmacy by contacting the surgery or your pharmacy.

Repeat prescriptions are available only to patients who are stabilised on medication. Your condition will need to be reviewed from time to time by your doctor.

Child Development Clinics

Dr Indrakumar is the surgery's nominated lead for Child & Young Peoples Safeguarding. A copy of our Child Safeguarding Statement of Intent is available from the Practice. Dr Natarajan and Dr Aung hold clinics at the surgery to undertake child development checks at 6-8 weeks of age. Attendance is by prior appointment.

Minor Surgery

We undertake certain minor surgery procedures, including, joint injections, excision of lumps and toe nail removal. Contact the surgery for details.

Family Planning

A full range of family planning services are provided. Dr Rahman and Dr Hirani can fit IUCDs and Implanon. This is by appointment only.

<u>District Nurses & Health Visitors</u>

The District Nurse and Health Visitor teams work in cooperation with the surgery to provide community care to patients.

The District Nurses provide home nursing services mainly for the elderly, the housebound and chronically sick.

The Health Visitors usually work with families and young children.

Midwifery Services

If you have a positive pregnancy test you can refer yourself to a hospital of your choice for your maternity care. Basildon Hospital, Broomfield Hospital or Queens Hospital.

Out of Hours Emergencies
